Why the First 7 Years Are Everything

Dr. **Bruce Lipton**, cell biologist and author of *The Biology of Belief*, explains:

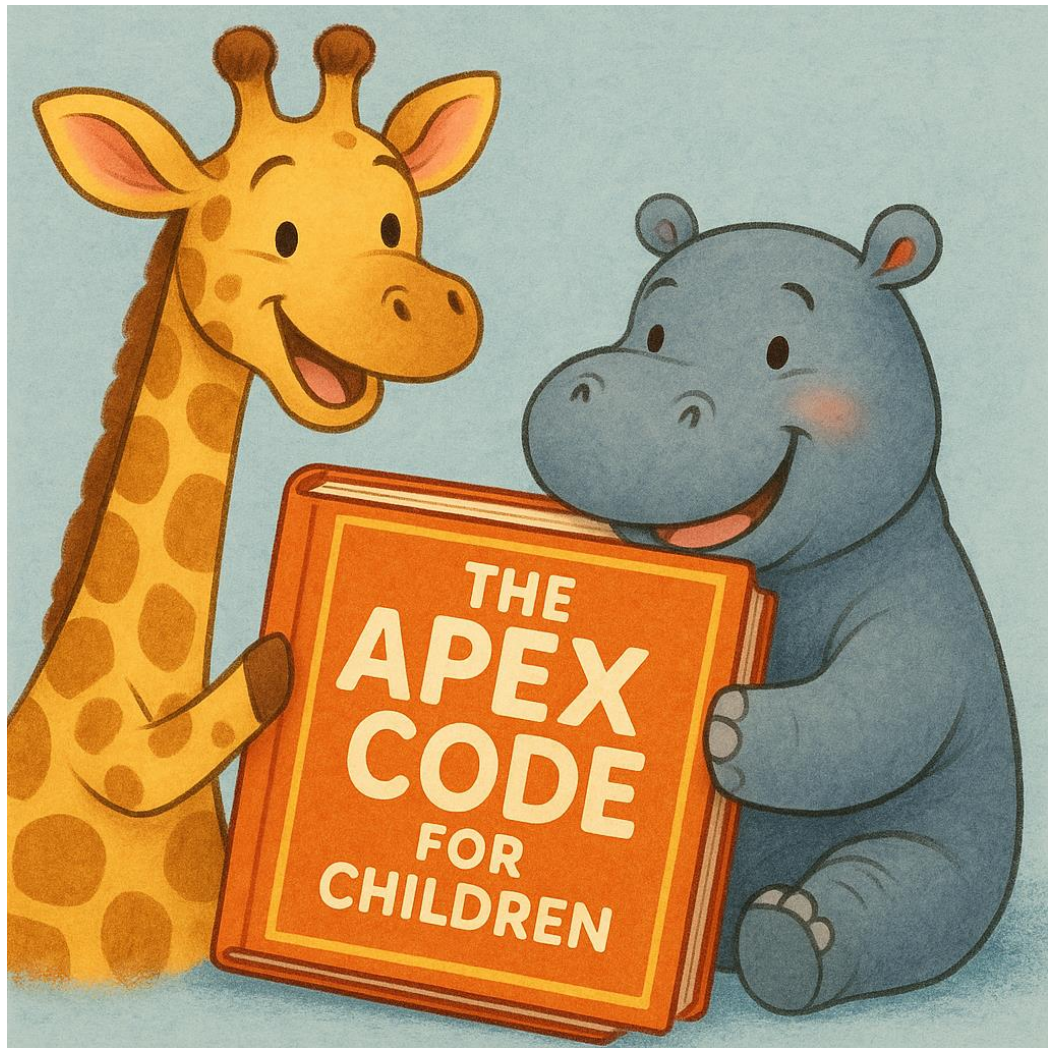
“The first seven years of a child’s life are like downloading software — not conscious thinking, but subconscious programming.”

That means:

- Beliefs, behaviors, emotions, and self-worth are all being recorded
 - Children live mostly in **theta brainwaves** (deeply programmable subconscious)
 - This time sets the foundation for **health, confidence, success, and love**
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The Science: Epigenetics for Kids

- **Epigenetics** shows that *genes are not destiny*.
- Children’s brains and bodies are shaped by:
 - Emotional environment
 - Repetition and rhythm
 - Coherence between parent and child
 - Loving routines & high-vibe interactions



You don't need to be perfect.
You need to be **present, authentic, and connected.**

What The Apex Code Offers for Families

Element

Benefit for the Child

Calm, rhythmic
music

Builds heart-brain harmony and focus

Element	Benefit for the Child
Story-based learning	Installs values and vision through imagination
Games with meaning	Encourages leadership, problem-solving, confidence
Affirmations + Touch	Rewires belief through feeling + repetition
Loving worldview	Creates trust, curiosity, and inner safety

“Teach children with love, not fear. Show them the world is beautiful and they are too.” — *The Apex Code*

Tips for Parents: Apex Practices at Home

1. **Be the example** – not the lecture
 2. **Keep routines with rhythm** – children thrive with flow
 3. **Say powerful things often:**
 - “You are safe.”
 - “You are smart.”
 - “You are loved.”
 - “You’re allowed to explore.”
 4. **Create a calm bedtime ritual** with music, storytelling, and gratitude
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Parent & Child Reflection Questions

For Parents:

- Am I creating a peaceful emotional atmosphere at home?
- Do I model the behavior I want my child to learn?
- Am I healing my own inner child while raising this one?

For Kids (age 5+):

- What makes you feel brave?
- What makes your heart happy?
- Who do you want to be when you grow up — and why?



The Apex Holistic Kindergarten Concept

A model for high-performance childhood, honoring languages, culture, neuroscience, and heart

Daily Flow (Examples)

Time	Activity	Learning Language & Culture
Morning	Song circle + mindful movement	Spanish (songs), Japanese (counting)
Snack	Shared storytelling over food	Italian (kitchen words), Arabic (gratitude)
Arts	Nature-based creative projects	French (colors, emotions), Chinese (symbols)
Calm	Breathwork, rest, quiet music	Sanskrit (mantras), German (body awareness)
Circle	“One World, Many Homes” game	English, Swahili, Korean — through play

Children don’t “study languages.”
They **live** them — through art, food, games, kindness, sound.

Core Apex Elements

- **Heart-Brain Coherence** in rituals (music + breathwork)
 - **Language as Love** – no tests, no pressure
 - **Teachers as Cultural Guides**, not just educators
 - **Natural Environments** – not plastic boxes
 - **Family Participation** – stories from parents in native tongues
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Real Cultures, Real Wisdom

Culture	What It Brings
Hawaiian	Aloha mindset + spiritual awareness
Swedish	Outdoor flow + calm confidence
African (Zulu, Yoruba)	Rhythm, storytelling, respect
Japanese	Harmony, patience, and precision
Arabic	Rich poetry, gratitude, and hospitality
Quechua	Earth wisdom and connection to nature

Parent Reflection

- What languages are in our family that we can bring into play?

- What *values* do we want our child to absorb through culture?
- How can we create a *language-rich* home: music, phrases, stories?

Real-World Learning Starts Early

At Apex, we believe children should explore **real professions** from the start — not just wait for college. Why?

Weekly Immersion Labs & Visits

Theme	Activity
Science Lab	Mixing safe experiments, learning curiosity + cause-effect logic
Robot Lab	Building basic robots or coding small commands — play meets logic
Artist's Studio	Painting, music, movement, emotional self-expression
Café & Kitchen	Measuring ingredients, teamwork, taste and hospitality
Interactive Museum	Touch + learn zones about earth, body, space, history
Nature & Farming	Planting seeds, caring for animals, understanding time & growth

Each experience is guided by **professionals who love their work** — so children not only learn **what** people do, but also **why** they love it.

The Apex Educator Code

“No one teaches a child better than someone who’s still learning with joy.”

Apex Teachers are:

- Passionate explorers
- Calm listeners
- Guides, not bosses
- Respectful, not reactive

They encourage children to **ask questions, try things,** and **share their opinions** — not just follow instructions.

Peer Learning & Weekly Reflection

Every week, children practice **self-expression and listening** in a safe circle.

“Apex Learning Circle” — every Friday morning

Each child shares:

1. **What I learned this week**
2. **What I loved most**
3. **What I didn’t enjoy or found hard**
4. **What I want to try next time**

These circles build:

- Confidence in speaking
- Self-awareness
- Appreciation for others

- Emotional literacy

Even shy kids begin to blossom — because **everyone's voice is equal.**

Final Message to Parents

Don't ask your child: "What did you do today?"
Ask instead:

- "What did you discover today?"
- "Who did you help?"
- "What made you smile or think deeply?"
